Call Display	On	*65	The caller's name and number is displayed while your phone is ringing. Requires a call display capable telephone.
	Off	*85	
Automatic Recall	*69		Dials the number of the last incoming call you received.
3-Way Calling			<p>Allows you to contact 2 telephone numbers at the same time and conduct a simultaneous conversation with both people. How to use it:</p> <p>Make or receive a call</p> <p>Inform the other person on the call that you are about to add a third party</p> <p>Press the 'Flash' button on your phone. <i>If your phone does not have a 'flash' button, you can quickly press and release the 'hang up' or 'on hook' button.</i></p> <p>When the call is answered, press the "Flash" button once more to to add the person who is waiting to the call.</p>
Call Forwarding (Basic)	*72nnnnnnnnnn		Allows you to forward all incoming calls to another number regardless of whether the line is busy or there is no answer. How to use it: To control call forwarding from your phone, use the following access codes. nnnnnnnnnn represents the number to which you want to forward your calls

Do Not Disturb	On	*78	Lets you block your line temporarily to prevent incoming calls, or if used at the Selective Call Acceptance level, allows only calls from specific numbers to ring through.

Call Waiting			<p>Allows a single number to hunt to multiple lines within the same business. Calls to the Hunt Group are passed to a non- busy line within the Hunt Group, or may be added to a queue if all lines are busy</p> <p>How to use it:</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Press the 'Flash' button on your phone. <i>If your phone does not have a 'flash' button, you can quickly press and release the 'hang up' or 'on hook' button</i></p>
Speed Calling	To Set-up 1 digit Speed dial numbers - *74		<p>Set up your phone system so that you can use short codes to call your frequently used numbers.</p> <p>How to use it: To set up Speed Calling from your phone, use one of the following access codes. You will hear a broken dial tone*. Dial the Speed Calling code you want to use, followed by the full telephone number you want to access using that code. You will then hear a confirm tone.</p> <p>To use the feature for outgoing calls, dial the speed dial code followed by the pound (#)</p>
	To Set-up 2 digit Speed dial numbers - *75		
Voicemail	*98		Access your voicemail from home using *98. Once your passcode is set, you can access your voicemails away from home. Call your home, wait for the voicemail prompt, then press * followed by your password.
